A note received from Whites on the 1988 refurbishment states: “Five of the bells have had their cast-in wrought iron clapper staples and their canons removed and the 3<sup>rd</sup> bell has been recast. They have been re-hung complete with new ringing fittings in a new cast-iron and steel (anti-clockwise circle) bell frame. The bells have been harmonically tuned in the key of G (Old standard pitch).” The note then lists the weights (presumably measured while re-hanging).

The bells also had their original sleeve bearings replace with sealed roller bearings during the refurbishment. The original wooden frame dated from mediaeval times, a small part of this was turned down to form the present bell shaped “spider” (upon which the ropes can be hung and drawn towards the ceiling).
